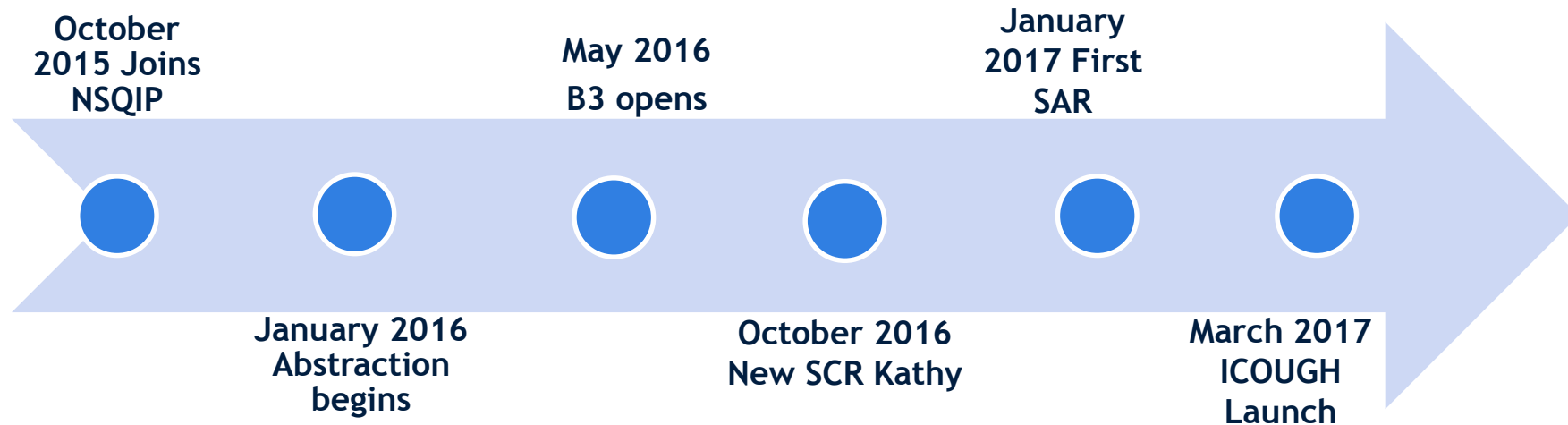

# Historical Background

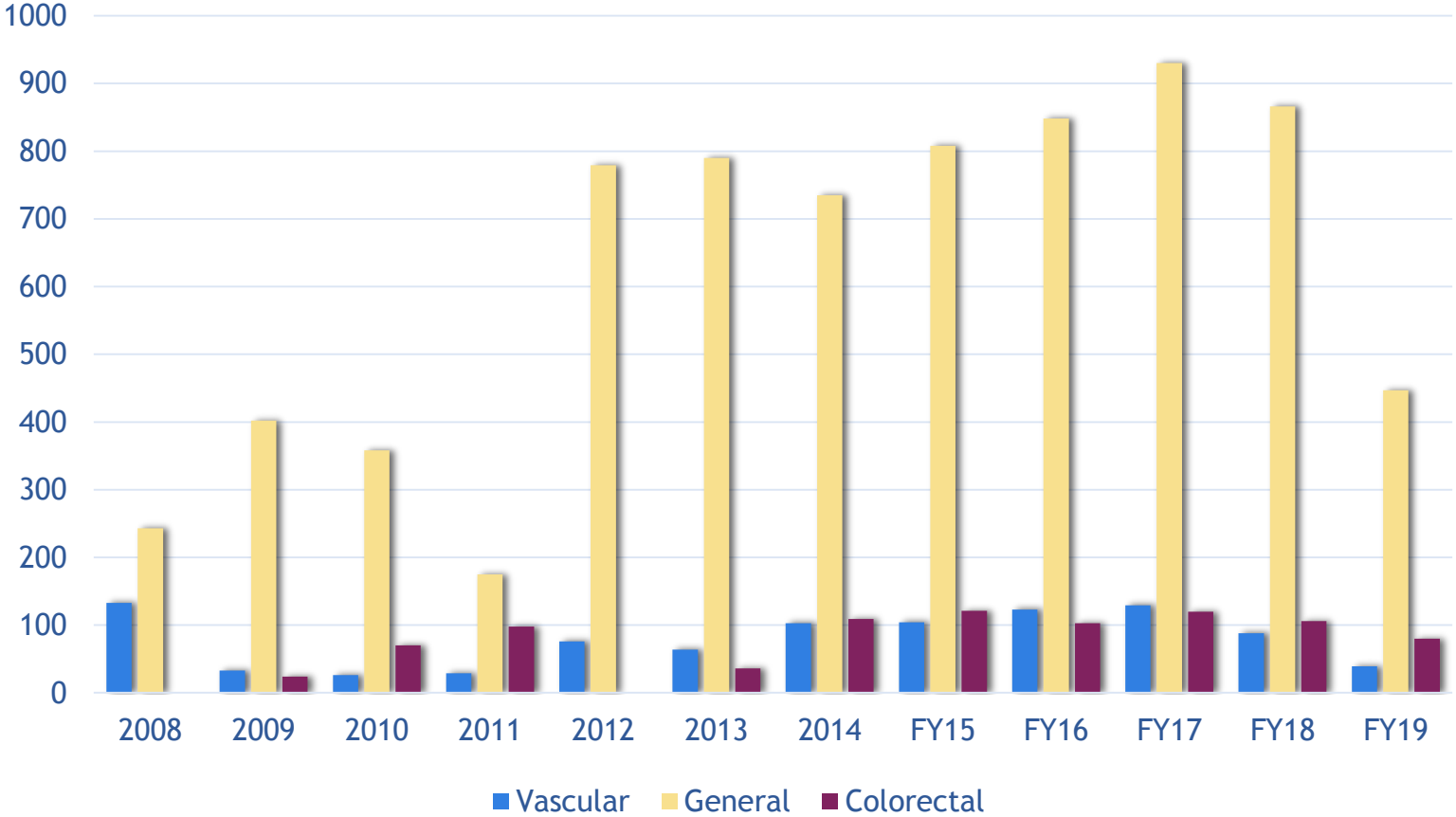
- Methodist first opened its doors to the South Philadelphia Community as Methodist Episcopal Hospital in 1892
- Pennsylvania hospital 1751; St Agnes 1888; graduate hospital 1889; Mt Sinai 1905
- In 1950, M.E.H. began its affiliation with Jefferson Medical College and agreed to make its ward facilities and staff available for clinical teaching
- In 1996, Methodist Hospital became a division of Thomas Jefferson University Hospital.



# Jefferson Methodist Hospital ACS NSQIP TimeLine

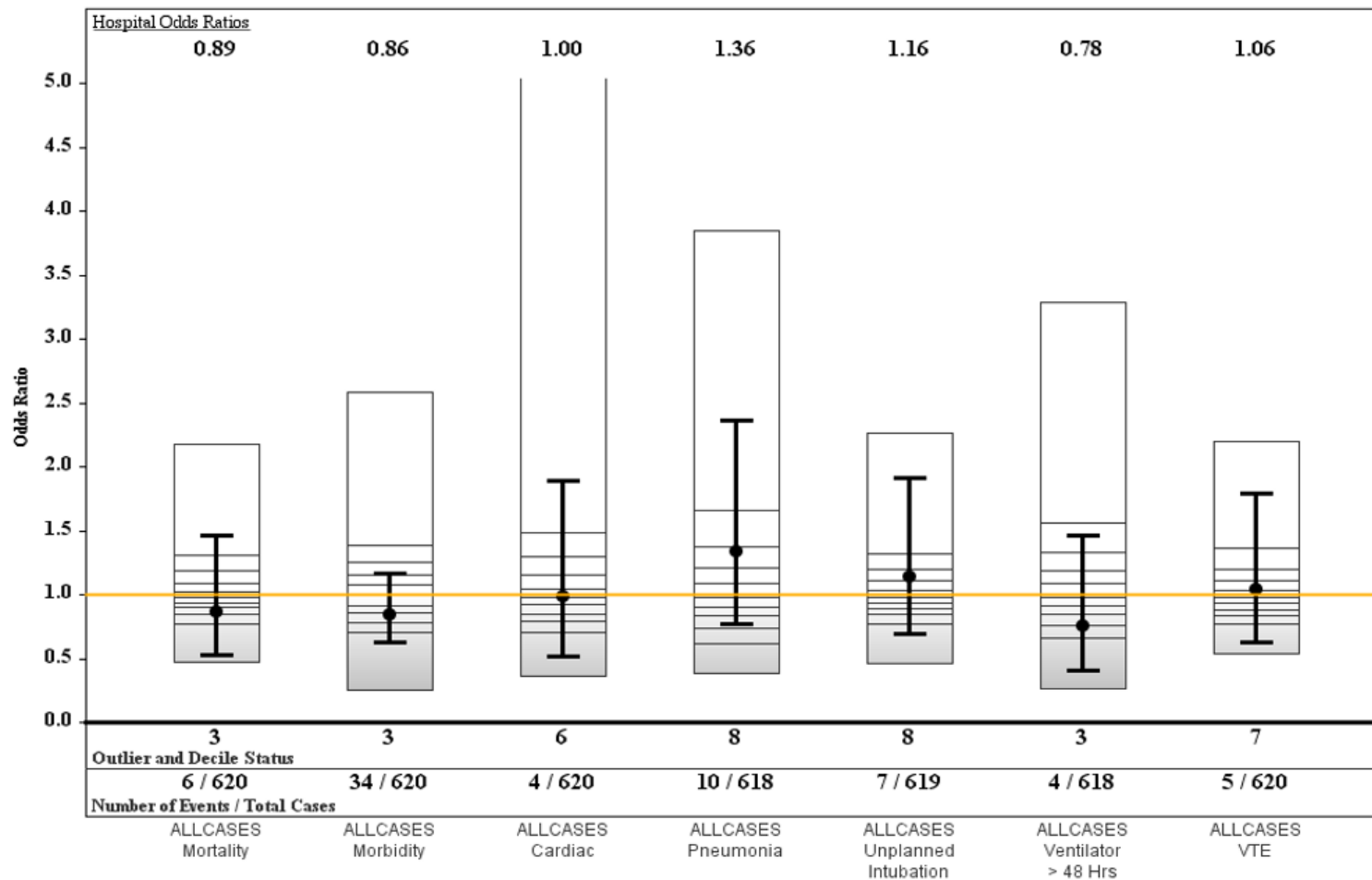

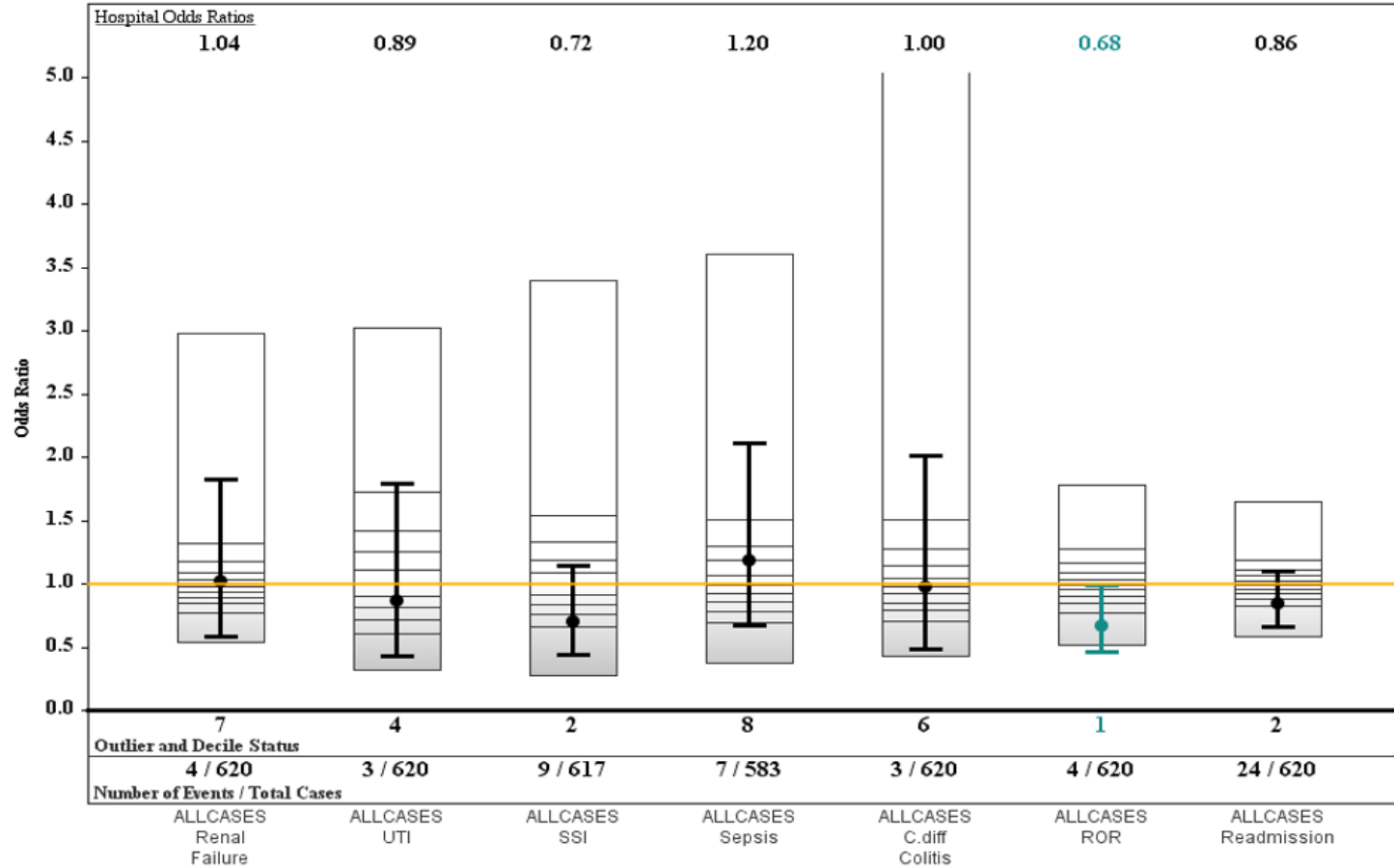

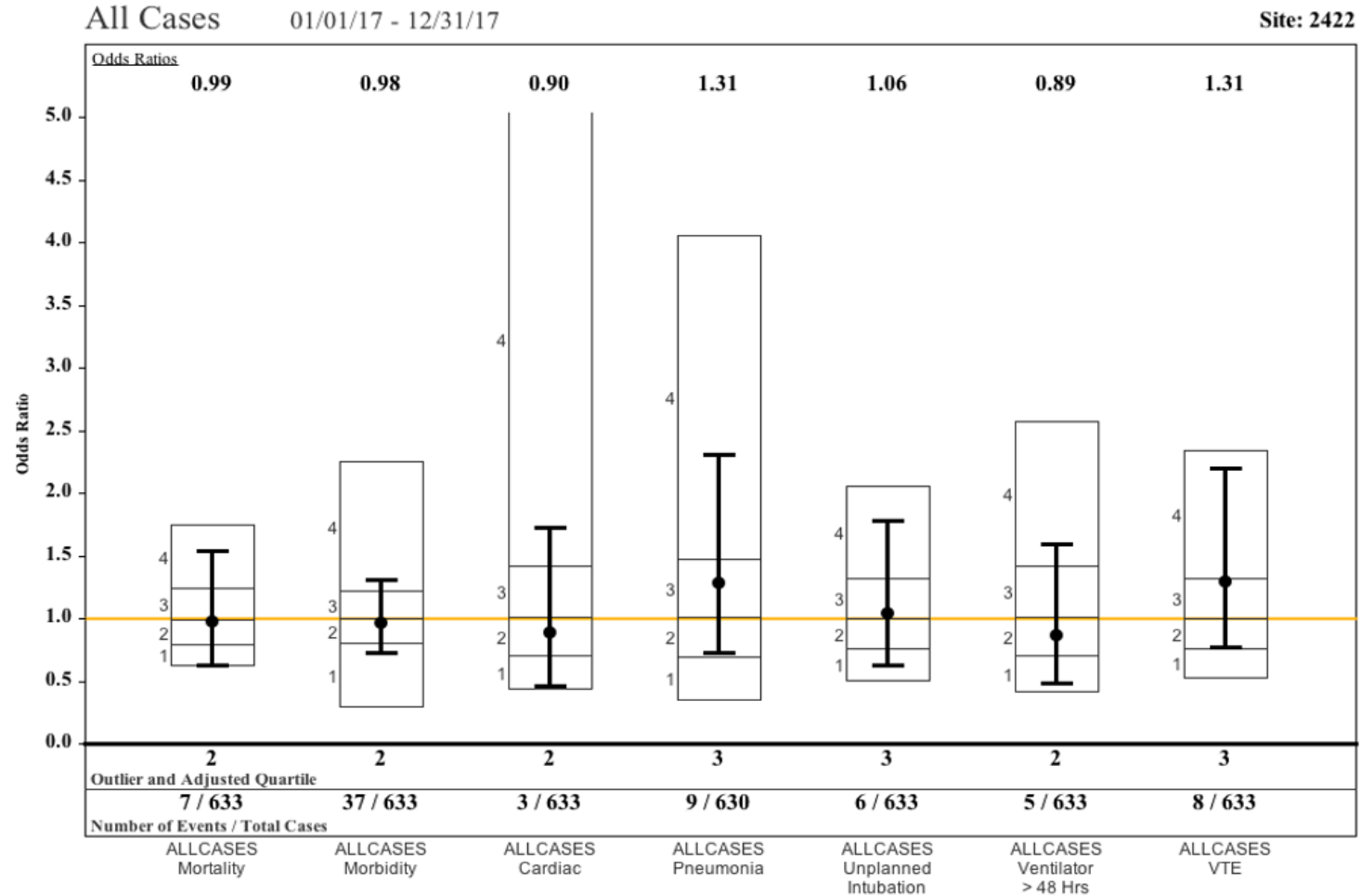

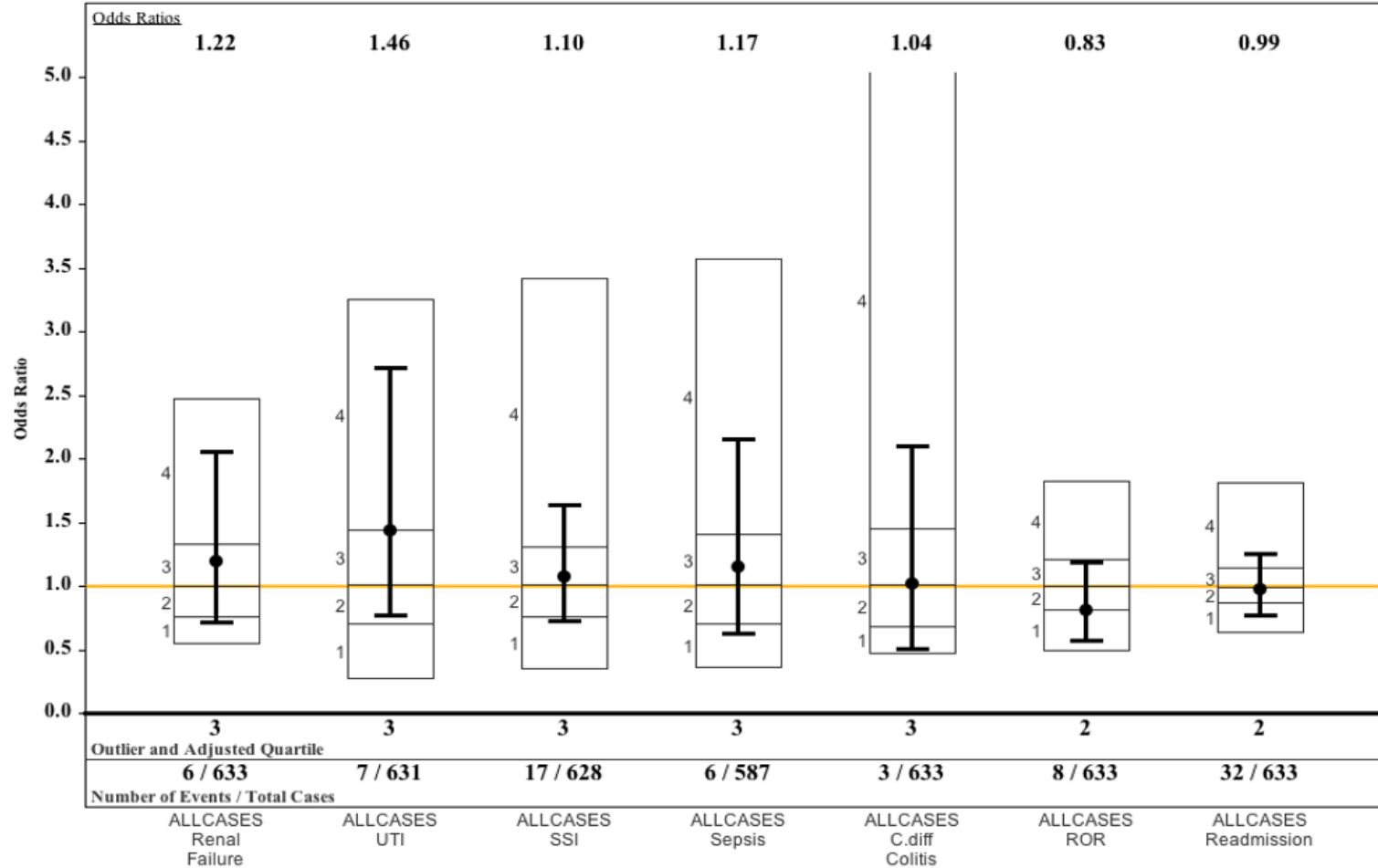

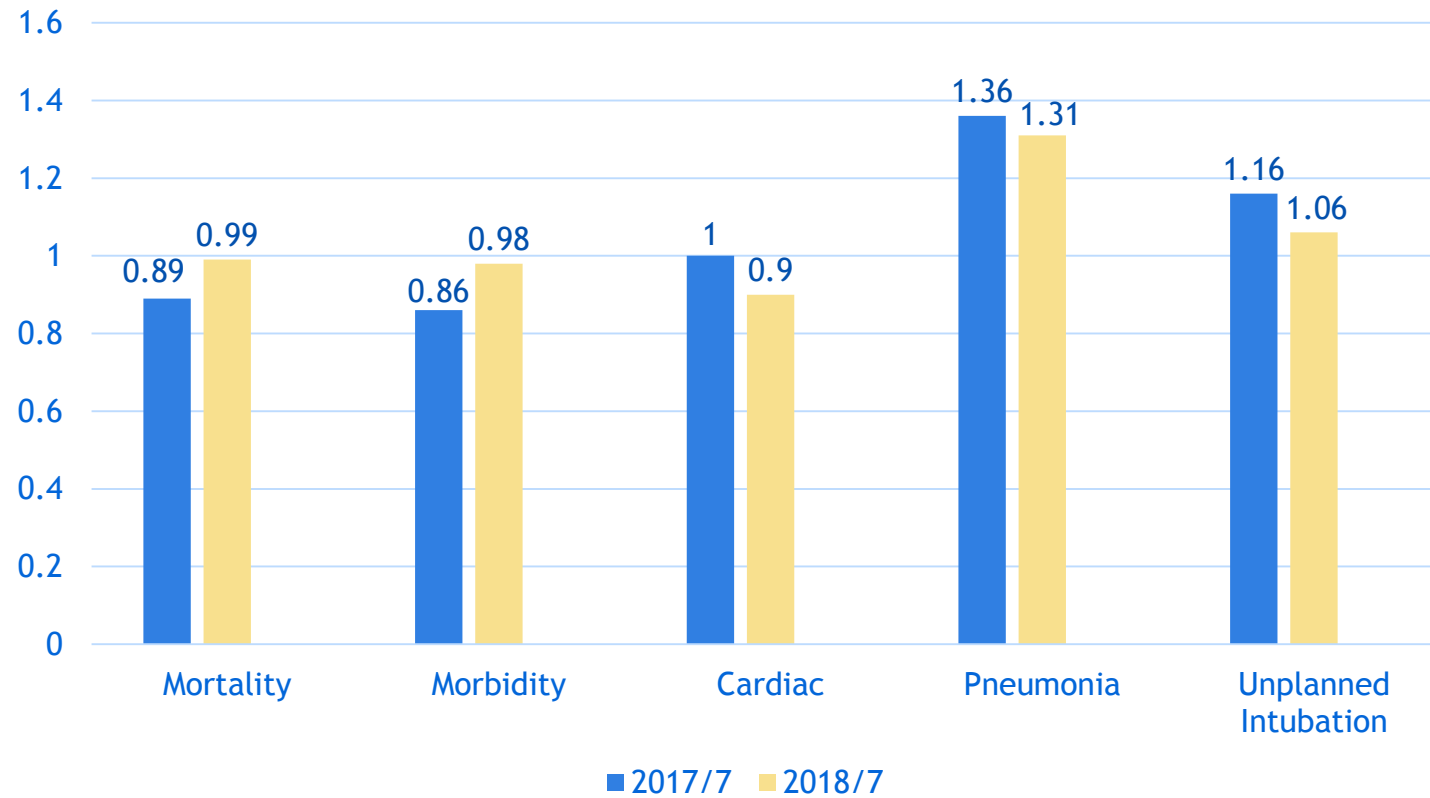

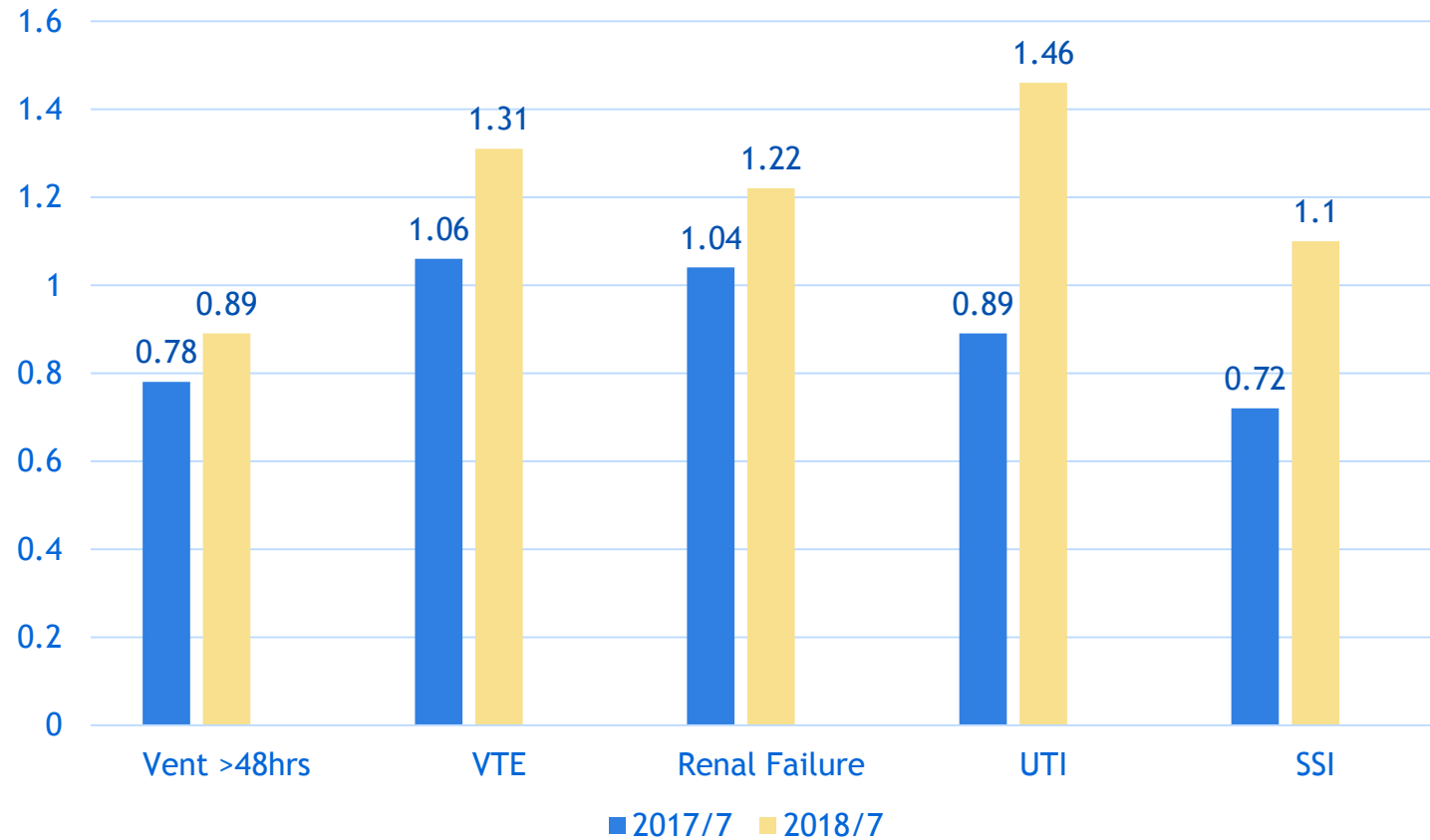




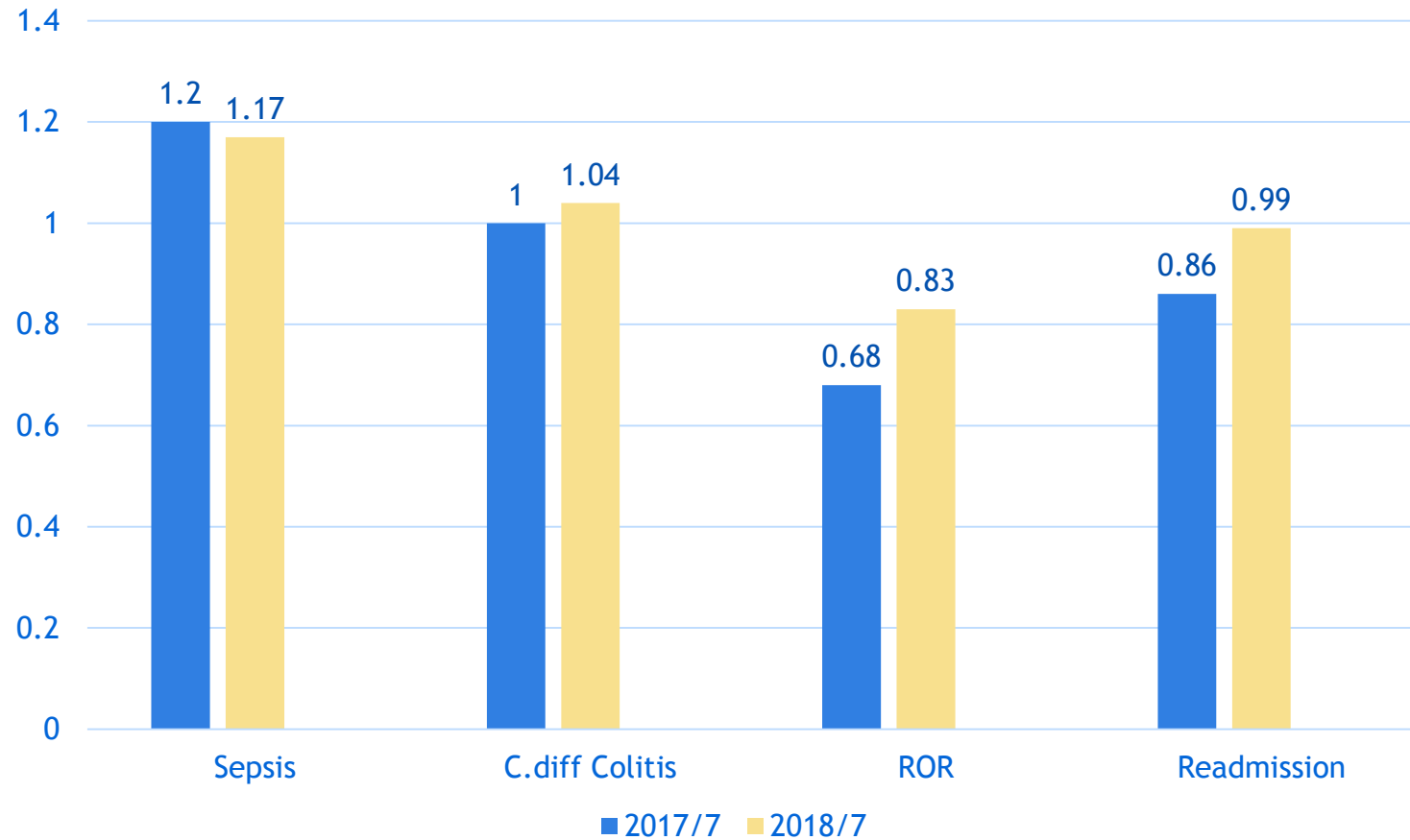
## SAR Comparison Odds Ratio July 2017 vs July 2018
